Pre-registered voters are required to provide an approved form of identification at the polling place before receiving and casting a regular ballot. Voters who are not pre-registered, such as voters registering to vote on Election Day, and voters changing precincts must also provide proof of residence. A voter who is unable to provide an approved form of identification (or prove residence if required) may have voter’s identity/residence attested to by another registered voter in the precinct, prove identity and residence using Election Day Registration documents, or cast a provisional ballot and provide proof of identity/residence at the County Auditor’s office by April 20, 2026, at Noon. Election Day Registrant attestors must provide an approved form of identification. The Post-Election Audit will be 10:00 A.M. on April 16, 2026.

Voter pre-registration deadline is 5:00 P.M. March 30, 2026, at the Crawford County Auditor’s office. Absentee ballots are available in the County Auditor’s office during regular business hours.
