The Board met with Kim Fineran, Public Health Co-Administrator to discuss Public Health concerns associated with COVID-19.

The Board approved the following Underground Utility Permit:

No. 20-13 – Windstream Communications – Installation of an underground electric cable along the north shoulder of D Ave. (aka E16) at the bridge replacement between 240th and 250th Street.

All Board Members are in concession of informal action that as of March 17, 2020 at noon, the county Board of Supervisors will waive sick leave policies and allow employees to borrow ahead on sick leave after all other benefits have been expelled. The Board also met with Louise Galbraith, General Relief to discuss future services.

The Board met with Christ Gosch, Conservation Director to discuss new hires starting during the closure of offices.
