The Board of Supervisors met at 9:00 o'clock A.M. with Cecil Blum, Chairman presiding. All members were present.

Minutes of the previous meeting were read and approved.

The Board approved the following Underground Utility Permits:

No. 20-41 – Windstream Communications – Installation of an underground communications cable commencing near the intersection of G Ave. and 250<sup>th</sup> St. thence north along the west side of 250<sup>th</sup> St. 2600 feet.

No. 20-42 – Windstream Communications – Installation of an underground communications cable commencing near the intersection of C Ave and Hwy 39 thence east along the north side of C Ave. 143 feet.

At 10:15 o'clock A.M., as advertised, a motion was made by Vogt, seconded by Skoog to open the public hearing regarding the third reading of the proposed Nuisance Ordinance. Motion was passed unanimously. There were no written or oral objections.

A motion was made by Vogt, seconded by Schultz to close the public hearing at 10:25 o'clock A.M. Motion was passed unanimously.

A motion was made by Muhlbauer, seconded by Schultz to adopt the proposed Nuisance Ordinance.

Voting Aye: Muhlbauer, Blum, Schultz and Vogt. Voting Nay: Skoog. Motion passed.

The Board discussed soil samples for the County Farm. No action was taken at this time.

The Board approved the Clerk of Court Fees for November 2020.

The Board met with Steve Hallaren and Michelle Carlson of the Family Crisis Center for their Annual Report and annual request for funding.

During Citizen's Input the Board met with Jake Langholz, IT Director to discuss e-mail issues, and electronic devices for newly elected officials.
