The Board of Supervisors met at 9:00 o'clock A.M. with Jeri Vogt, Chairperson presiding. All members were present, Rosburg was present via Zoom.

Minutes of the previous meeting were read and approved.

The Board approved the following Underground Utility Permits:

No. 21-10 – Frontier Communications – installation of a 25 pair telecommunications cable along Union Ave. commencing at the intersection of 180th St. thence southwest along the south side of Union Ave a distance of 1400 feet.

No. 21-11 – Frontier Communications – installation of a Fiber and copper cable commencing along north side of O Ave. at a point 1900 feet east of Donna Reed Rd. thence west to the intersection of Donna Reed thence south along the west side of Donna Reed Rd 1057 feet.

No. 21-12 Western Iowa Power Coop – installation of underground electric cable along the east side of Deloit Blvd commencing at 1650 Deloit Blvd thence south 360 feet.

A motion was made by Schultz seconded by Heiden to approve the Secondary Road Department IDOT Budget and 5-Year Program for FY ending June 30, 2022.

Motion was passed unanimously.

A motion was made by Skoog, seconded by Heiden to approve the Hungry Canyons Alliance Agreement 21-1 providing \$36,000 in funding for Culvert Replacement Project LC50-8N located on B Ave. just east of 170th St.

Motion was passed unanimously.

A motion was made by Schultz, seconded by Skoog to proclaim April 2021 as Child Abuse Prevention Month in Crawford County.

Motion was passed unanimously.

A motion was made by Heiden, seconded by Schultz to approve the Abatement of taxes on parcel 13-11-208-001 for a total of \$563.00.

Motion was passed unanimously.

The Board approved the Recorder's Quarterly Report for January – March 2021.

The Board approved the Sheriff's Quarterly Report for January – March 2021.

A motion was made by Schultz, seconded by Heiden to approve the Courthouse Tower site maintenance estimate for dirt backfill and rocker covering, fence repair and straightening the wall blocks.

Motion was passed unanimously.

The Board met with Chris Gosch, Conservation Director to discuss the Yellow Smoke Trail.
