The Board of Supervisors met at 9:00 o'clock A.M. with Jean Heiden, chair presiding. Members present were Schultz, Dozark, Heiden, Muhlbauer, and Rosburg.

Minutes of the previous meeting were read and approved.

A motion was made by Muhlbauer, seconded by Rosburg to approve the Engineering Services Agreement with Calhoun-Burns Associates, Inc. for Bridge Inspection/Load Ratings for 2024 and 2025.

Motion was passed unanimously.

A motion was made by Dozark, seconded by Muhlbauer to approve IDOT Budget and 5-year Construction Program for FY ending June 30, 2025.

Voting Aye: Dozark, Rosburg, Muhlbauer and Heiden. Abstaining: Schultz. Motion was passed unanimously.

At 10:00 o'clock A.M., as advertised, a motion was made by Muhlbauer, seconded by Dozark to open the public hearing regarding an auction of the County Farm land lease. Motion was passed unanimously. Jim Reiser was the high bidder at \$355.00 per acre. A motion was made by Schultz, seconded by Dozark to close the public hearing at 10:10 o'clock A.M. The Board agreed to enter into a lease agreement with Jim Reiser for the County Farm at \$355.00 per acre with the lease commencing on March 1, 2025.

Motion was passed unanimously.

Cory Snowgren, Denison Fire Chief, spoke to the Board about a Storm Warning Siren being placed at Yellow Smoke Park. A motion was made by Schultz, seconded by Dozark to approve a Storm Warning Siren at Yellow Smoke Park, cost sharing with the City of Denison, estimate around \$16,500.00.

Motion was passed unanimously.

A motion was made by Rosburg, seconded by Dozark to approve the National Public Health Week Proclamation, April 1–April 7, 2024.
