Minutes of the previous meeting were read, corrected and approved.

The Board had a discussion about the Zoning Administrator.

A motion was made by Schultz, seconded by Muhlbauer to approve the Letter of Understanding between Crawford County, IA and the Crawford County Secondary Roads Bargaining Unit regarding alternate schedule (10-hour days) from May 8th through September 10th.

Motion passed unanimously.

A motion was made by Rosburg, seconded by Heiden to approve the purchase of a 2023 CAT D5-17LGPV Dozer from Ziegler CAT for \$199,500.00, with trade-in of Crawford County Secondary Road's 2013 CAT D6T Dozer valued at \$90,000.00. To be paid for in FY2027, pending budget approval.

Motion passed unanimously.

At 10:00 o'clock A.M., a motion was made by Heiden, seconded by Rosburg to open the public hearing for the Consideration of Resolution #2026-10 Officially Declaring Emergency Medical Services in Crawford County to be an Essential Service – 2nd Reading.

There were no written objections. There were attendees from EMS and CCMH employees. Motion passed unanimously. At 10:22 o'clock A.M. a motion was made by Heiden, seconded by Rosburg to close the hearing.

A motion was made by Muhlbauer, seconded by Heiden approved the 1st action of Resolution #2026-10.

A motion was made by Heiden, seconded by Schultz to approve setting the time, date, and location for a Public Hearing for Proposed Property Tax Levy for March 31, 2026, at 5:30 o'clock P.M. in the Board of Supervisor's Board Room on the Second Floor of the Courthouse.

A motion was made by Schultz, seconded by Heiden to approve the appointment of Rachel Jacobson, as a Trustee for Morgan Township.

Motion passed unanimously.

A motion was made by Rosburg, seconded by Muhlbauer to approve the changing of positions for Morgan Township, Rachel Jacobson as Clerk and Ross Wood as a Trustee.

Motion passed unanimously.

At 10:40 o'clock A.M., a motion was made by Schultz, seconded by Heiden to open the Closed Session per Iowa Code 21.5(j) to discuss possible purchase or sale of real estate, which allows for a closed session. Motion passed unanimously. At 11:04 o'clock A.M., a motion was made by Heiden, seconded by Rosburg to close the Closed Sessions. Motion passed unanimously.
