The Board of Supervisors met at 9:00 o'clock A.M. with Craig Dozark, chair presiding. Members present were Schultz, Muhlbauer, Dozark, Heiden, and Rosburg.

Minutes of the previous meeting were read and approved.

On motion, the Board recognized claims for the Public Health Department and approved claims for all other departments.

The Board approved the hiring of Eric Rasmussen, FT Deputy, Sheriff's Office.

The Board approved the resignation of Traci Deets, Assessor's Office.

A motion was made by Rosburg, seconded by Heiden to approve the Crawford County Secondary Roads IDOT FY27 Budget and Program.

Motion passed unanimously.

At 10:00 o'clock A.M., as advertised, a motion was made by Muhlbauer, seconded by Rosburg to open the public hearing regarding the Budget for FY 2026/2027. Motion passed unanimously. Resolution 2026-19  
Health Insurance Premiums – Plan Year 2026/2027

WHEREAS, Crawford County offers to employees, retirees and their families, a health and RX benefits package, known as the Crawford County Health Plan, and

WHEREAS, Crawford County has opted to partially self-fund Blue Choice – Plan 14 and partially self-fund Blue Choice Plan 16, high-deductible plan, the Crawford County Health Plan in order to provide these benefits in a more economical manner than traditional insurance programs, and

WHEREAS, the Crawford County Board of Supervisors, through premiums paid from funds it appropriates in its budget and levy, as well as premiums paid by enrolled employees, retirees and COBRA participants, have funded the Crawford County Health Claims Fund at a level necessary to pay the health plan benefits for premiums, as administered by Wellmark Blue Cross and Blue Shield through IGHCP (Iowa Governmental Health Care Plan), and

WHEREAS, the Crawford County Board of Supervisors have Agent of record, Holmes Murphy and Wellmark Blue Cross and Blue Shield on the renewal for the Health Plan, and

WHEREAS, the Crawford County Board of Supervisors with the assistance of Holmes Murphy reviewed the plan design and premium rates, and

WHEREAS, the Crawford County Board of Supervisors determined that the plan should be offering a “wellness” plan with the option of a \$1,500 deductible and \$3,500 deductible have recommended that premium rates be adopted by the Crawford County Board of Supervisors as listed on Schedule A attached,

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Crawford County Board of Supervisors, State of Iowa on this 28<sup>th</sup> day of April 2026 that the premiums listed on Schedule A be adopted and charged by the Crawford County Health Plan to its employees, retirees and COBRA participants effective July 1, 2026.
